

## **Birch Hall Field Centre – Terms, Conditions & Site Rules**

### **Forestry Lease Conditions:**

The site is leased to us from the Forestry Commission on the understanding that the following conditions are adhered to:

- No caravans or any type of sleeping vehicles are brought, and no vehicles allowed on the field. No trees should be felled nor axes or saws be taken into the woods. Fallen timber should be brought back to the site before chopping or sawing. Forestry huts and wood piles are out of bounds and all gates are kept shut. Fires must only be made on alters provided. No turf fires.
- A high voltage power line passes over the site. Kite flying and climbing of pylons is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN

### **Site Rules:**

- Leaders are responsible for behaviour of their young people at all times. Please check equipment on arrival and report any non conformities or damage to the warden. The site is regularly maintained but you are requested to fulfil your responsibility and leave the hut, toilets and site clean and tidy or you may forfeit the retention fee.
- No televisions should be brought on site. We do not have a TV licence. The fine will be yours!!

### **Winter Camp Bookings**

- The site is not accessible by two wheel vehicular transport during times of snowfall. On average this happens twice a year. There can also be periodic problems with frozen water pipes.
- Due to the remote location of Birch Hall Field Centre a site reconnaissance visit is advised.
- If in any doubt about weather and access please contact the booking secretary for advice.
- A full refund will be offered for any camp cancelled due to poor access due to bad weather.
